WHAT IS THE ACM?

The Association for Computing Machinery (ACM) is the oldest and largest international scientific and educational computer society. Founded in 1947, it now has over 80,000 members. ACM publishes numerous journals and books, offers 34 special interest groups, and has 170 professional chapters and local chapters plus 750 student chapters around the world. ACM sponsors many of the leading conferences in the computing field as well as such annual events as the International Collegiate Programming Contest and the International Computer Chess Championship.

The GSU chapter of the ACM offers you a chance to hear speakers on the latest topics in the computing field, visit local companies and research centers, and exchange ideas with other students and faculty in an informal setting.

Students may join the GSU student chapter of the ACM, the national organization, or both. The application on the following page is for membership in the student chapter only. Applications for national ACM are available from chapter officers, or visit www.acm.org.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Regular membership in the GSU chapter is open to any full-time or part-time student at Georgia State University who is enrolled in or has satisfactorily completed a basic course in computer information systems, computer science, or a related field, and who has at least an overall C (2.0) average.
2. A member of national ACM who is not a student at GSU may, upon request and payment of dues, become a voting member of this chapter.
3. A member of the GSU community who is not a member of the national ACM may, upon payment of a fee that is equal to the voting member dues, receive meeting notices and attend business meetings of this chapter.
